1 CLIMATE

- Maltese law offers security to financiers/ mortgagees of Maltese registered vessels and there are no restrictions on the sale or mortgaging of Maltese registered yachts and superyachts.
- Maltese registered mortgages constitute executive titles and may be enforced immediately without the need to institute lengthy court proceedings.
