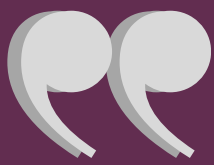

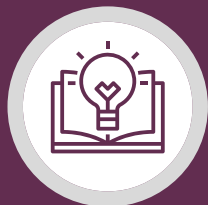

- Standard progressive tax rates – 0%, 15%, 25% or 35%, depending on salary
- 35% for relocating individuals for the first 183 days
- Tax imputation and refund system
- Standard VAT rate of 18% on taxable supplies and goods
